Examples

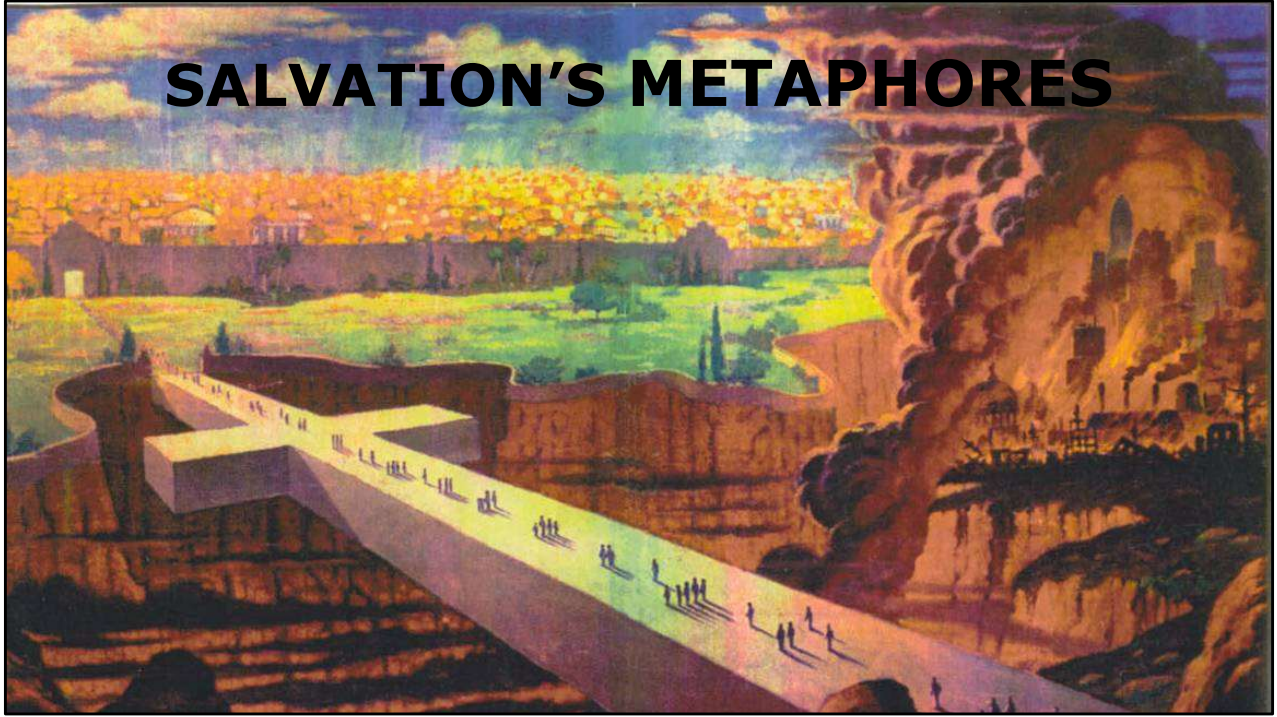



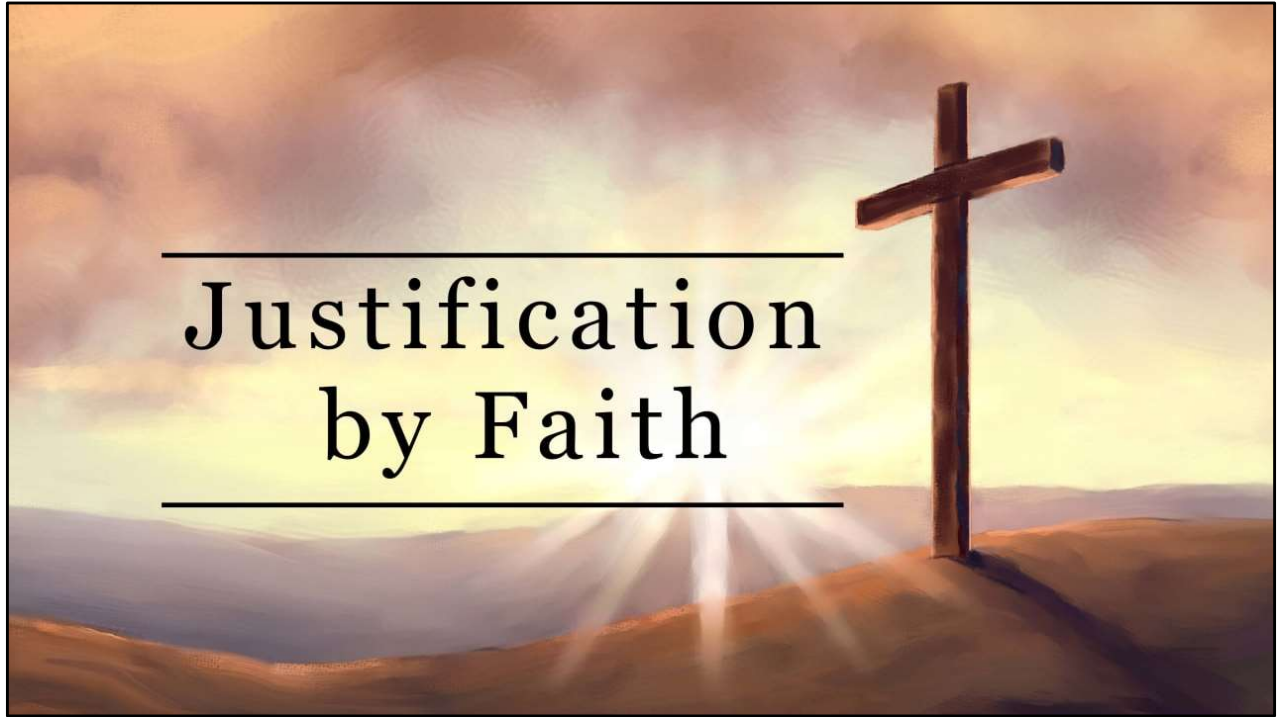

Dikaiosune

- We are declared Righteous by God based on the righteousness of Christ on our behalf.

Dikaiosune

Our sin is transferred to Jesus and His righteousness is transferred to us.

God views us as righteous not because we are actually righteous but because the righteousness of Christ covers us.

When God's righteousness is mentioned in the gospel, it is God's action of declaring righteous the unrighteous sinner who has faith in Jesus Christ. The righteousness by which a person is justified (declared righteous) is not his own but that of another, Christ.

²³ Yes, all have sinned; all fall short of God's glorious ideal; ²⁴ yet now God declares us "not guilty" of offending him if we trust in Jesus Christ, who in his kindness freely take away our sins

26. But isn't this unfair for God to let criminals go free, and say that they are innocent?

No, for He does it on the basis of their trust in Jesus who took away their sins.

27 Then what can we boast about doing to earn our salvation? Nothing at all. Why? Because our acquittal is not based on our good deeds; it is based on what Christ has done and our faith in him.

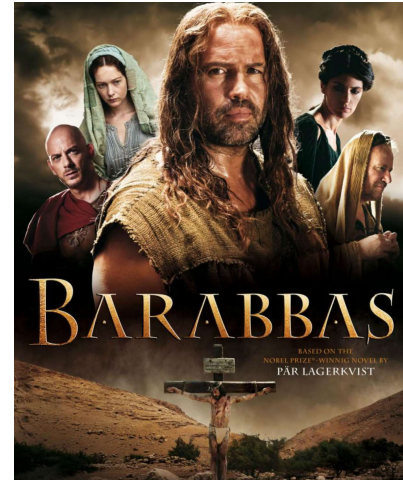
