A man's heart deviseth his way: but the LORD **directeth his steps**. Proverbs 16:9

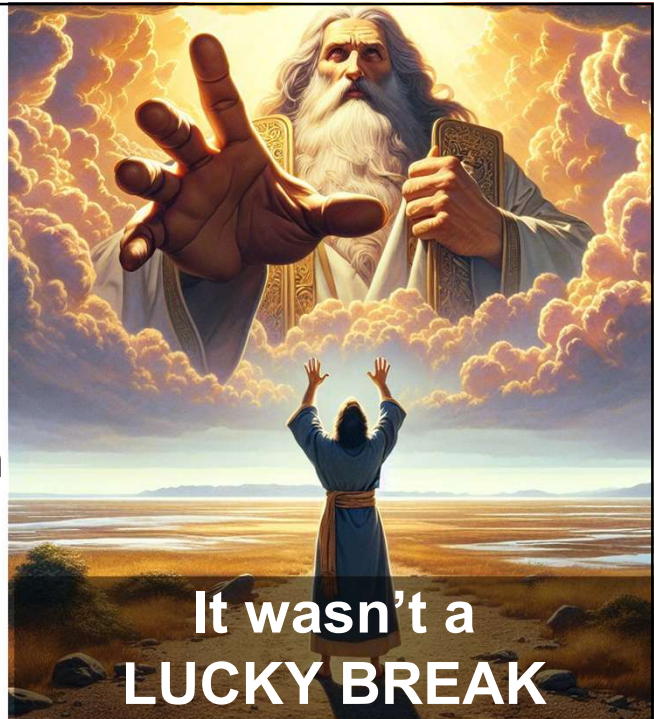

¹⁷ And thou say in thine heart, My power and the might of mine hand hath gotten me this wealth.

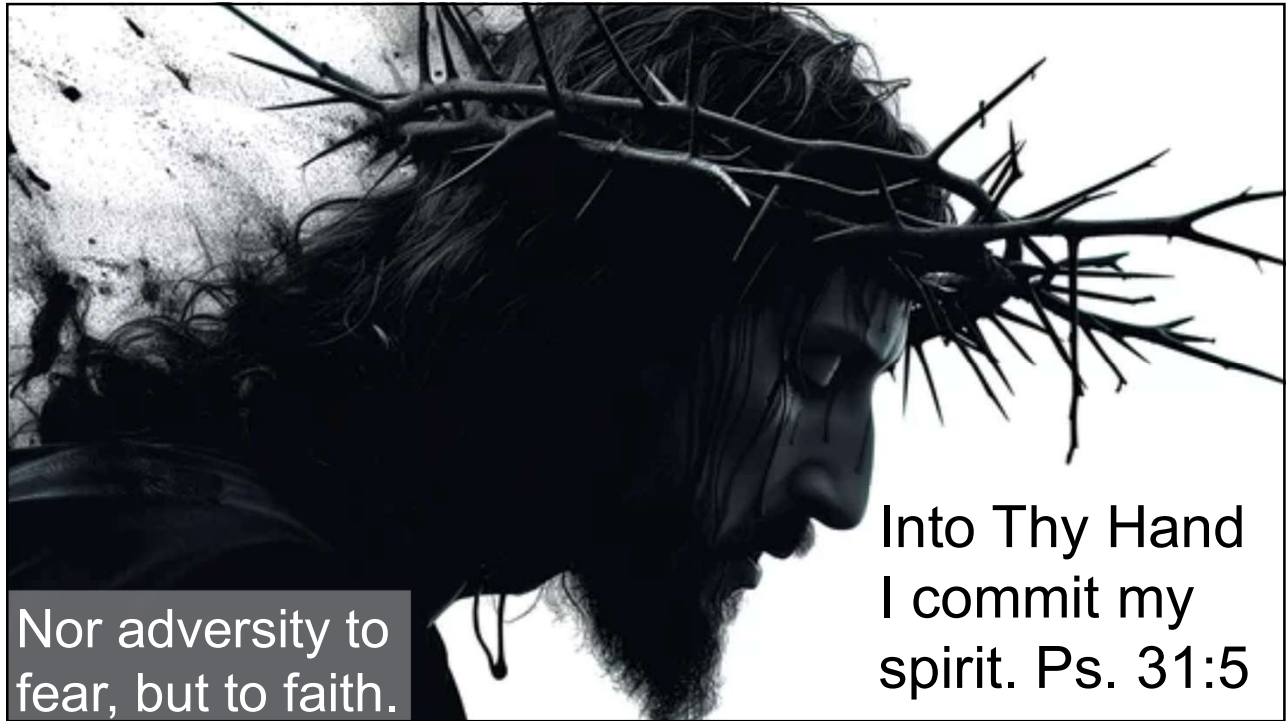

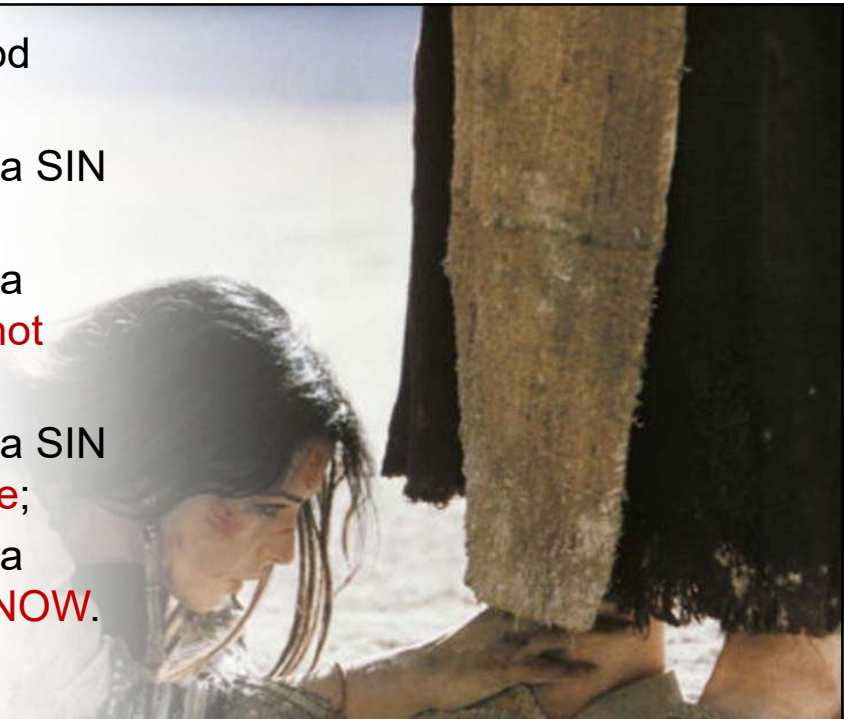




There are 4 things God does not know:
