When Solomon finished praying, **fire came down from heaven** and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the **glory of the LORD filled the temple**. ² The priests could not enter the temple of the LORD because the glory of the LORD filled it. ³ When all the Israelites saw the fire coming down and the glory of the LORD above



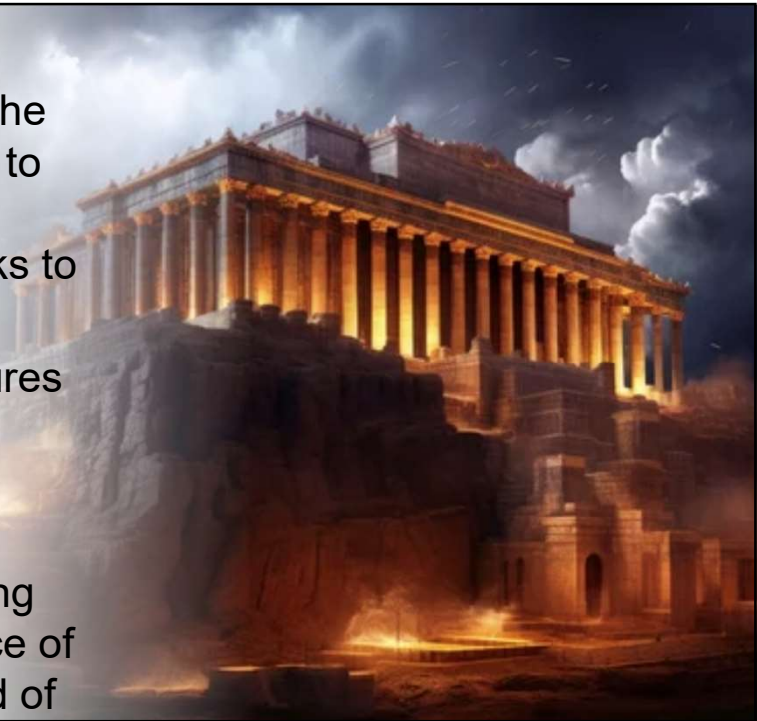

“He is good; his love endures forever.”

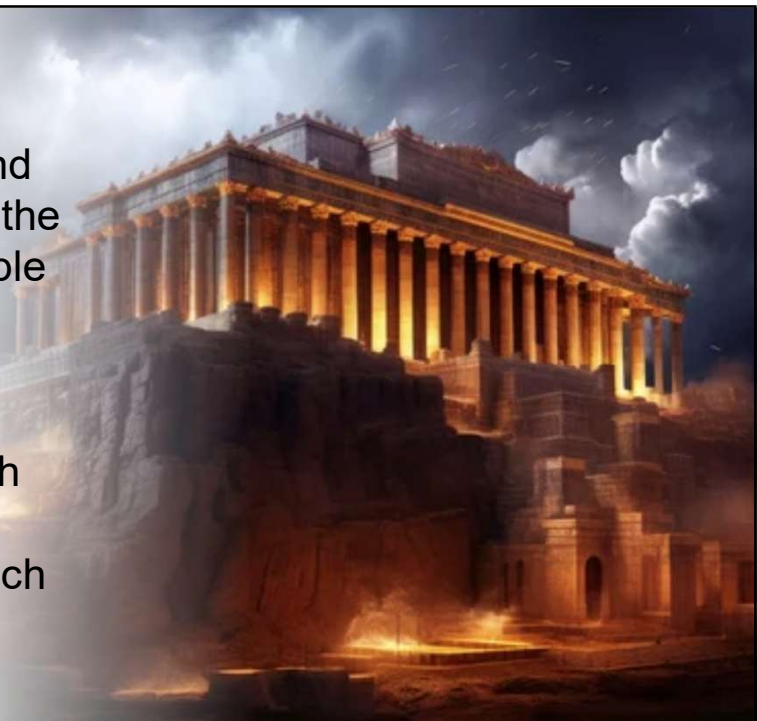
⁴ Then the king and all the people offered sacrifices before the LORD. ⁵ And King Solomon offered a sacrifice of twenty-two thousand head of

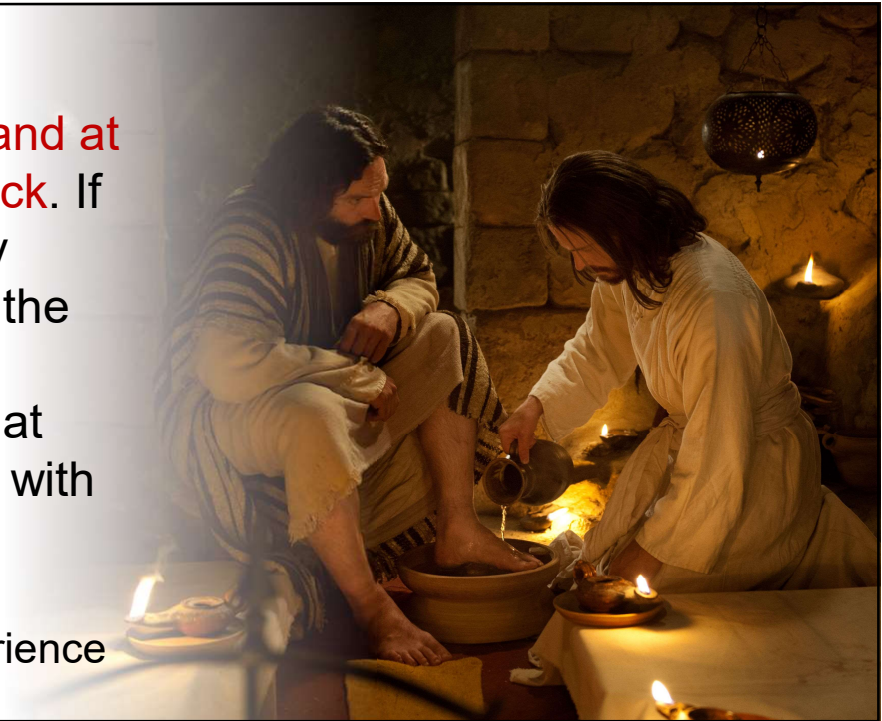
