**Genesis 3:4** – The serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die. For god knows that in the day you eat thereof, your eyes shall be opened, and you shall be as gods ...

**Isaiah 8:19,20** – When they say unto you, 'Seek unto them that have familiar spirits and unto wizards that peep and mutter': Should not a people seek unto their God? To the Law and to the Testimony: If they speak not according to this word, there is no light in them.

**Matthew 4:1-4** – It is written, man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.

Ecclesiastes 9:5 – For the living know that they shall die: but the dead know nothing.

**Genesis 2:7** – the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul.

**Ecclesiastes 12: 7** – then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.

**1 Timothy 6:14-16** – Jesus Christ ... only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light ...

Acts 7:59,60 – And they stoned Steven, calling upon God and saying Lord Jesus, receive my spirit ... and when he has said this, he fell asleep.

**Acts 2:29,34** – The patriarch David is both dead and buried, and his sepulcher is with us unto this day. For David is not ascended unto the heavens.

**John 11:11**-14 – [Jesus] said to them, "our friend Lazarus sleeps, but I go that I may awake him our of sleep". Howbeit Jesus spoke of his death ... Jesus plainly told them "Lazarus is dead".

1 Thessalonians 4:13-17 - <sup>13</sup> But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. <sup>14</sup> For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. <sup>15</sup> For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: <sup>17</sup> Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

**John 5:25** - <sup>25</sup> Verily, verily, I say unto you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.

**John 5:28,29** - <sup>28</sup> Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, <sup>29</sup> And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the **resurrection of life**; and they that have done evil, unto the **resurrection of damnation**.

**Hebrews 1:14** - Are angels not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

**Daniel 8:19** - And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: for at the time appointed the end shall be.

Ezekiel 28:12-19 - 12 Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.

<sup>13</sup> Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering <sup>14</sup>Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: <sup>15</sup> Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee. <sup>16</sup> therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub. <sup>17</sup> Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee. <sup>18</sup> therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. <sup>19</sup> All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and never shalt thou be any more.

**Revelation 12:7-9** - <sup>7</sup> And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, <sup>8</sup> And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. <sup>9</sup> And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceives the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

**2 Thessalonians 2:9** - Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders

2 Corinthians 11:14 - And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

**1 Samuel 28:3-16** - <sup>3</sup> Now Samuel was dead, and all Israel had lamented him, and buried him in Ramah. And Saul had put away those that had familiar spirits, and the wizards, out of the land. <sup>4</sup> And the Philistines gathered themselves together. <sup>5</sup> And when Saul saw the host of the Philistines, he was afraid, and his heart greatly trembled. <sup>7</sup> Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that hath a familiar spirit, that I may go to her, and enquire of her. And his servants said to him, Behold, there is a woman that hath a familiar spirit at Endor. <sup>8</sup> And Saul disguised himself, and they came to the woman by night: and he said, I pray thee, divine unto me by the familiar spirit, and bring me him up, whom I shall name unto thee. <sup>9</sup> And the woman said unto him, Behold, thou knowest what Saul hath done, how he hath cut off those that have familiar spirits, and the wizards, out of the land: wherefore then layest thou a snare for my life, to cause me to die? <sup>10</sup> And Saul swore to her by the Lord, saying, As the Lord lives, there shall no punishment happen to thee for this thing. <sup>11</sup> Then said the woman, Whom shall I bring up unto thee? And he said, Bring me up Samuel. <sup>12</sup> And when the woman saw Samuel, she cried with a loud voice: and the woman spoke to Saul, saying, Why hast thou deceived me? for thou art Saul. <sup>13</sup> And the king said unto her,

Be not afraid: for what sawest thou? And the woman said unto Saul, I saw gods ascending out of the earth. <sup>14</sup> And he said unto her, What form is he of? And she said, An old man cometh up; and he is covered with a mantle. And Saul perceived that it was Samuel, and he stooped with his face to the ground, and bowed himself. <sup>15</sup> And Samuel said to Saul, Why hast thou disquieted me, to bring me up? And Saul answered, I am sore distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God is departed from me, and answers me no more, neither by prophets, nor by dreams: therefore I have called thee, that thou mayest make known unto me what I shall do. <sup>16</sup> Then said Samuel, Wherefore then dost thou ask of me, seeing the Lord is departed from thee, and is become thine enemy?

**Deuteronomy 18:9-12** - <sup>9</sup> When thou art come into the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. <sup>10</sup> There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch <sup>11</sup> Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. <sup>12</sup> For all that do these things are an abomination unto the Lord: and because of these abominations the Lord thy God doth drive them out from before thee.

**Ephesians 5:11** - Take no part in the worthless pleasures of evil and darkness, but instead, rebuke and expose them.

- a. By submitting to God and departing from evil
- b. By the Blood of the Lamb
- c. By the Word of God
- d. By using the Name of Jesus
- e. By letting the stronger man bind the strong man

**Revelation 12:11** - And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

**Revelation 20:1-10** - And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit (abyss) and a great chain in his hand. <sup>2</sup> And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, <sup>3</sup> And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

<sup>4</sup> And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. <sup>5</sup> But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. <sup>6</sup> Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. <sup>7</sup> And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, <sup>8</sup> And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog, and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. <sup>9</sup> And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them.

<sup>10</sup> And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

**Zechariah 14:4,10** - <sup>4</sup> And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south. <sup>10</sup> All the land shall be turned as a plain...

**Joel 3:9,12** - <sup>9</sup> Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near; let them come up: <sup>12</sup> Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about

Psalm 50:6 - And the heavens shall declare his righteousness: for God is judge himself.

**Phillipians 2:9-11** - <sup>9</sup> Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: <sup>10</sup> That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; <sup>11</sup> And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

**2 Peter 3:10** - But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

**Matthew 25:41** - Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels

**Ezekiel 28:18,19** - <sup>18</sup> ...therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. <sup>19</sup> All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and never shalt thou be any more

Malachi 4:1,3 - For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the Lord of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch.

**Zechariah 14:12** - And this shall be the plague wherewith the Lord will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth

**Jude 1:7** - Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire

**Nahum 1:9** - What do ye imagine against the Lord? he will make an utter end: affliction shall not rise up the second time.

**Revelation 21:1-4** - And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. <sup>2</sup> And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. <sup>3</sup> And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. <sup>4</sup> And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

**1 Corinthians 2:9** - But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him

**Isaiah 66:22,23** - <sup>22</sup> For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the Lord, so shall your seed and your name remain. <sup>23</sup> And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the Lord.

**Revelation 3:20** - Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.
