

⁹ And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.


¹⁰ And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;

FOLLOW THE CLOUD...




Psalm 24:7-10

But *this man*, after he had offered **one sacrifice for sins for ever**, *sat down on the right hand of God*;


14 For by **one offering** he hath **perfected for ever** them that are sanctified.



⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an Advocate (Parakleton) with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:



Our salvation is **grounded** in the **JUSTICE** of God. It is God's justice that **SCREAMS for Mercy** and **DEMANDS** the Salvation of the sinner because the Covenant's terms and conditions have been **fully met by Jesus' perfect life**, and by faith in His life, we are granted by His Amazing Grace the benefits and rewards of His obedience.

Hebrews 7:22

This makes <u>Jesus</u> the guarantor of a better covenant.

Romans 8

HEAD — The Golden Crown / Mitznefet (Holy Crown) "HOLINESS TO THE LORD" engraved on it (Exodus 28:36)

Jesus bears our name in holiness before the Father. When you pray, the Father sees Christ's holiness, not your sin.

You are accepted **because His holiness is credited to you.**

Intercession: He stands before God as your perfect righteousness.

SHOULDERS — Onyx Stones with the Names of the 12 Tribes (Exodus 28:9–12)

Two stones. Six names on each shoulder.

Jesus carries your entire identity and burden.
He does not intercede in general...
He literally carries your name before God personally.

Intercession: Your weaknesses are not an obstacle — you are raised up on His shoulders.

CHEST — The Breastplate of Judgment with 12 Precious Stones (Exodus 28:15–30)

Each stone = one name = over His heart. You are not only carried. You are cherished.

Judgment = He ministers with royal readiness — never delays your case. His intercession is not legal only. It is emotional.

Intercession: He pleads your case grounded in Divine Justice mixed with Mercy & Grace.

CHEST INTERIOR — Urim & Thummim (Divine Decision Light) (Exodus 28:30)

Light and perfection — used for divine verdicts, as Christ doesn't INTERPRET your case — He DECIDES it.

He is both your defense attorney AND the Judge (John 5:22).

Intercession: Your case cannot be lost — the Judge is your Savior.

ROBE — Blue Robe with Bells & Pomegranates (Ex. 28:31–35)

Bells = sound proves He lives Pomegranates = Fruitfulness of the Spirit He IMPARTS

His intercession is living and effective (Heb. 7:25)
Grace is poured into Jesus' lips. If He ever fell silent — humanity would die.

Intercession: Every breath Christ takes is prayer for you.

TUNIC / WHITE LINEN — Spotless Righteousness (Exodus 28:39–43)

White = purity, no stain

He atones and brings your sin to remission with His perfect obedience, offered to God with His own precious blood.

Intercession: God sees sinless obedience where you see failure.

Heb. 4:14-16

14 ...let us hold fast our profession.


15 For we have not an High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.




Heb. 4:14-16

MERCY vs GRACE








Jesus is the ONLY Advocate in the Universe that will take your case and win it, only if:

- 1. You confess that you are guilty up front,
- 2. You acknowledge that you don't have a penny to pay for His services, and
- 3. You zip it up and <u>let Him speak</u>, no excuses, ONLY TRUST quietly as He speaks to God on your behalf!
